This butterfly is great if you are new to machine embroidery, if you want to learn in-the-hoop techniques, or just want to make a beautiful project. Choose your hoop size: 5x7, 8x8, 6x10 or 8x10. The butterfly is done totally in the hoop, including attaching to a pillow top, tote bag, jacket back, etc. Or, it can be made to be free-standing as the back is also finished.

The hardest part to this quilt is where you will place your squares. Once placement has been determined just press to adhere blocks to foundation and then sew, No pins needed!!!! WaLa perfect corners!!

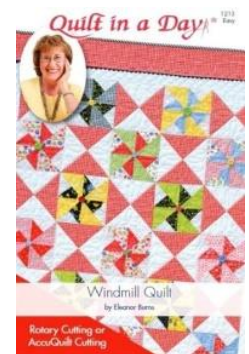
