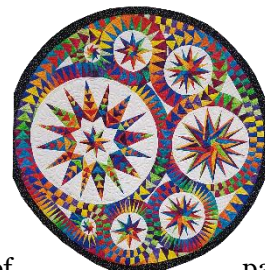

The 2nd class is 10 days later so that you will have time to do your homework.

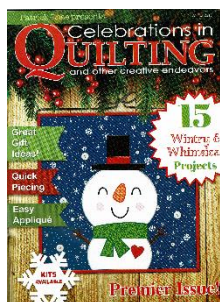

Then, we will be working on designs with paper and you will go home and stitch the designs. This has proven to be a very effective way to learn the rulers and you will not have to lug those big machines into class.
