The newly updated Laundry Day Tee comes with three neckline options- scoop, v-neck & cowl as well as five sleeve lengths- tank, short, elbow, 3/4 and long. You also get to choose from a regular tee shirt length, tunic length & dress. The tunic and dress lengths have a high/low hem option.

Order your pattern by putting "Laundry Day T" in your browser and ordering the appropriate size. Sophia knit is suggested for your fabric. It can be found at JoAnns. Thin knit is not suggested for this longer style. Please have pattern purchased and taped together before class. DO NOT cut out ahead of time as we will fine tune the fit. This is a tunic length T. We will be making the scoop neck, short-sleeved version.

If you are using your sewing machine be sure to bring a double needle.
