The purpose of this 6 class course is to familiarize yourself with the PE Design software so you will be able to create simple designs from scratch and to customize and edit existing designs. The Course will take you through the Layout and Editing feature of the software and will cover all of the tools on the Home Tab, Edit Tab, Arrange Tab, Attributes Tab, Sewing Order Pane and Attributes Pane. The tools in the Image Tab will NOT be covered as well as some of the more advanced tools. The Editing Tools will be explained using the

technique of defining “What, When, Why, and How” to use the tools. You will work on specific designs in order to practice what you are learning. The Design Database will also be covered. This course was designed for beginner software users who are interested in learning what it does and how it can help you create or edit designs.

Topic: Thursday, February 22 - Class 2, Beginning Digitizing: Shape Tools, Drawing Tools, and Arrange Tab: Select point tool, basic applique, adding applique to existing designs, alignment tool, mirror copy tool, 4 way mirror copy tool, circle copy tool, flipping and rotating designs.

Topic: Thursday, February 29 Class 3, Editing Designs: Selecting designs, grouping and ungrouping, changing color and stitch order, dividing stitches by color, removing a color, isolating part of a design, hole sewing.
