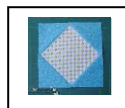
Are you a beginner quilter? This class will help you master key quilting techniques!

- How to sew Option 1 square in a square

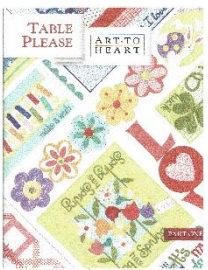
