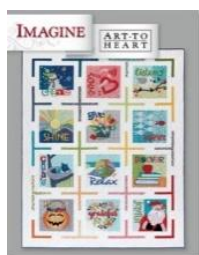

Longarm quilters have been using rulers to quilt with for many years and now you can quilt with rulers too on your domestic machine. We will do a small wall hanging with 9 blocks and also learn to put these blocks together with a quilt as you go easy method. You are going to love it. This is a beginner class, or for those that need a refresher. You will be required to bring your machine in on the first class. Then, we will be working on designs with paper and you will go home and stitch the designs. This has proven to be a very effective way to learn the rulers and you will not have to lug those big machines into class.
